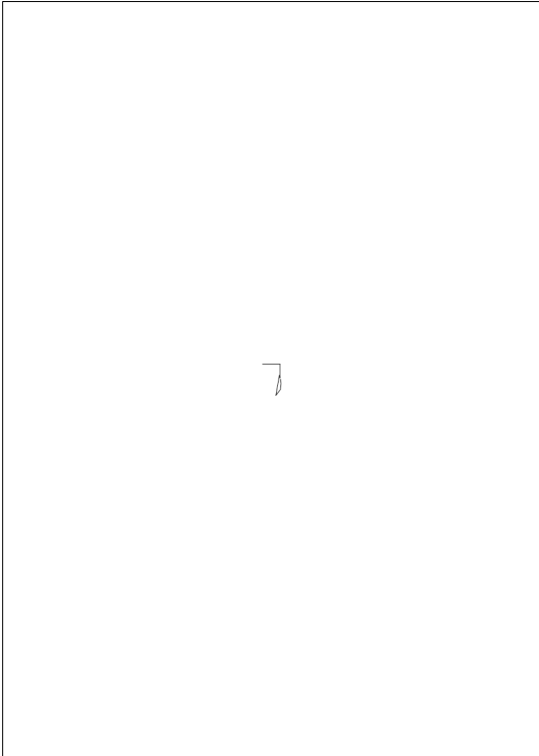

George the second & I know ye that we have given unto Nicholas Boon two hundred and eighty one acres of land in Bertie County on the river. Beginning at a red oak, white oak and pine in the Country line and 320 poles to a Beach in the Low Grounds then along John Bryants line East 120 po. to two Dogwood and an Oak, then N 96 po. to the river, then up the river, N 10 W 20 po. to a Beach, then N 10 W 144 po. to a Hickory, N 37 E 54 poles to a cypress, N 5 E 40 po. to a Gum, N 5 W 32 po. to a Beach, Menchams corner, then along his line, N 108 po. to a white oak in the Country line, thence to the Beginning - To Hold & C. at the 6th day of May 1742.
